

Mining section 2010 **Best opportunities for mining:**

Since 2004, the mining sector has been integrated into bauma. In 2010, no less than 90% of the visitors judged the integration of the mining area as "good" or "excellent." The high quality and quantity of visitors were proof of its success.

The 605 exhibitors involved in the mining sector—about 19 % of all the exhibiting companies, were of the same mind. There is no doubt that the mining sector at bauma benefited from the massively global character of bauma itself and enjoyed being part of the strong demand world-wide in the construction and mining industries.

Facts & figures of bauma China 2010:

bauma China 2010 has again broken all records with regard to exhibition space, exhibitor numbers and visitor numbers. Once more, bauma China has further consolidated its position as the leading trade show for the Asian construction industry. In 2010 1,892 exhibitors from 37 countries and 155,615 visitors from 171 countries (2008: 112,674 visitors from 124 countries) attended. 230,000 sqm of space were convered.
